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Project Description

The existing Hawk Falls Bridge (Bridge NB-610) is a 738'-long, three-span deck truss bridge with I-beam approach spans. It carries 2 lanes of I-476 (Pennsylvania Turnpike Northeast Extension) traffic in each direction over Mud Run in Penn Forest Township and Kidder Township, Carbon County. The replacement bridge is a 720' steel structure featuring a 480' deck arch with steel box arch ribs, which is intended to create an aesthetically pleasing structure within Hickory Run State Park.
