Rich belongs to Our Lady of Peace Parish at our Lady of Grace Church where he served as a parish lector.

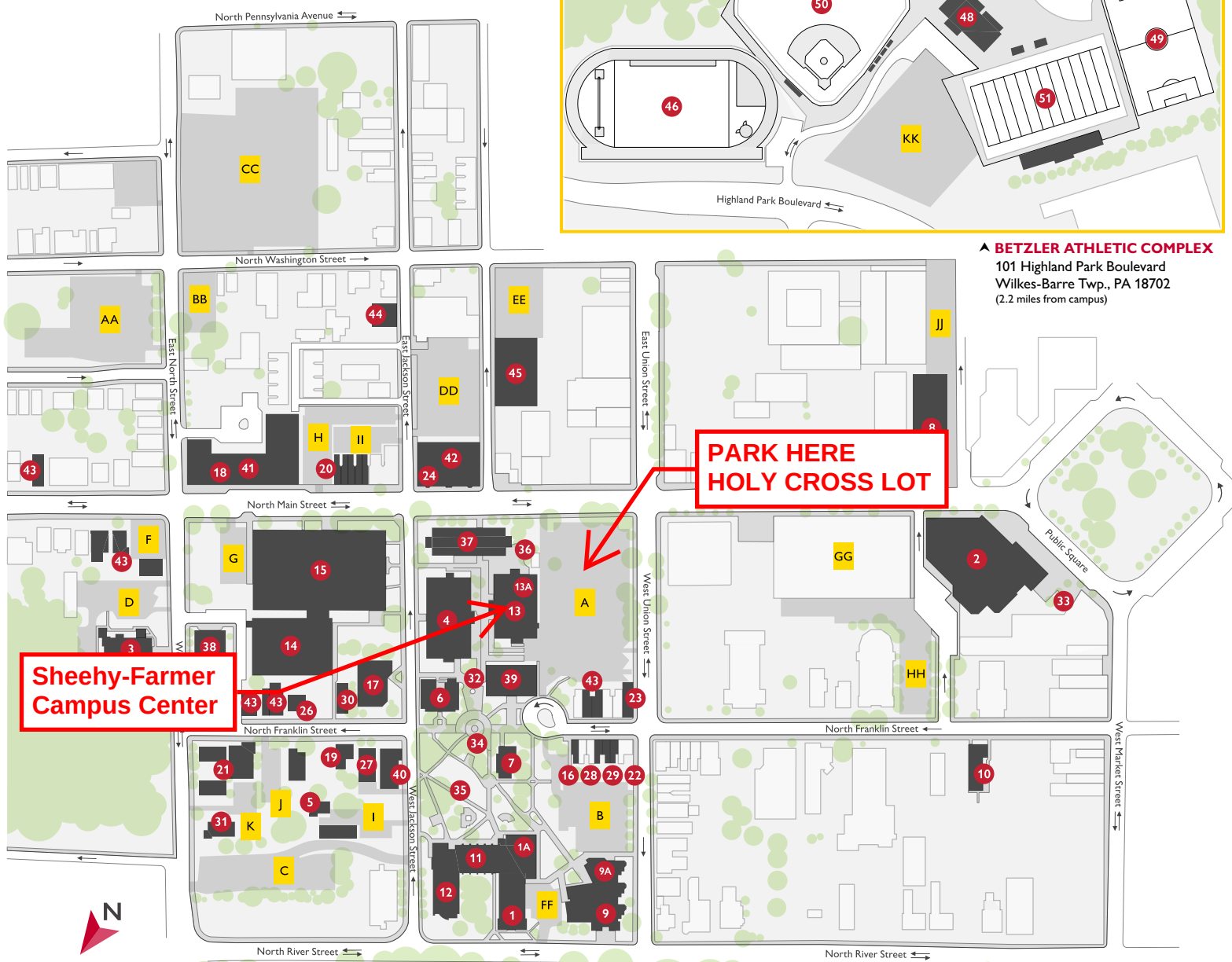
